



## “Changing the Landscape of Officiating”

MAGBO's **Women's Basketball Officiating Proficiency Course** is an intensive eight-week program, which is designed to provide an in-depth study of the rules, mechanics, and philosophies specifically geared to officiating women's basketball. This is an extension of MAGBO's Basketball Officiating Basics course, expanding upon the concepts and content at a higher level.

The course will focus on the most current **NCAA playing rules and mechanics**, giving participants the opportunity to apply these principles on the court. At the conclusion of this course, all participants will be given a two-part assessment covering rules knowledge and mechanics application. Those officials who demonstrate proficiency will be put in touch with local assignors and leagues, fostering an opportunity for further officiating experience.
